MISSION

Samarth Bharat aims to empower individuals across the nation, ensuring equitable access to opportunities for sustainable livelihoods thereby contributing significantly to the country's economic and social development.

OUR INSPIRATION

Shradheya Bhaorao Deoras Ji, born in Nagpur on 19th November 1917, was deeply influenced by Dr. Keshav Baliram Hedgewar, founder of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). He was sent to Uttar Pradesh in 1937 to expand RSS activities and excelled academically at Lucknow University, where he also invited Subhash Chandra Bose for an inaugural ceremony.

After his studies, he dedicated his life to social service, founding numerous institutions and shaping many lives. Notably, he established the first Saraswati Shishu Mandir in Gorakhpur in 1952, which has grown into a network of over 25,000 schools with around 2.5 million students and more than 100,000 teachers. His efforts spanned from Jammu & Kashmir to tribal areas in Jharkhand and Odisha, focusing on uplifting forest dwellers and urban slum residents deprived of health and education.

As the younger brother of the third Sarsanghachalak, Shri Balasaheb Deoras, Bhaorao ji mentored prominent leaders such as Pandit Deen Dayal Uppadhyay, Atal Bihari Vajpayee, and many others, promoting Bharatiya culture and socio-economic change. He passed away on 13th May 1992, but his legacy endures through the institutions he founded and the leaders he inspired.

THE BEGINNING

To honour Shradheya Bhaorao Deoras, a prayer meeting was held in Lucknow on 13th May 1993, the first anniversary of his death. Presided over by Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, the meeting reflected on Deoras ji's vision of aiding the underprivileged, including dalits, tribals, and those in rural and urban slums, by providing education, health, and other essential services.

In response, it was decided to establish a trust in his name to continue his work for these communities. The Bhaorao Deoras Sewa Nyas was founded on 29th December 1993 in Lucknow, with Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee as its Founder President.

ABOUT SAMARTH BHARAT

Samarth Bharat embodies a diverse approach to national development through various Skill Development Programs and Career Development Centers (CDCs). The Skill Development Program aims to empower vulnerable and marginalized communities by providing them with essential skills needed for active workforce participation. This endeavor fosters aspirational values amongst the youth by building capacity for skill development across formal and informal sectors. Further, it enables the generation of large-scale employment opportunities, thus contributing significantly to the nation's economic growth. Additionally, CDCs are set up in numerous colleges and universities to equip students with the essential tools and knowledge required to navigate the intricacies of entrepreneurship and the startup ecosystem. These centers serve as holistic development hubs for students, offering a range of services from mentorship by industry experts to platforms for startup and innovation initiatives.



MESSAGE FROM THE PATRON

Gratitude fills our hearts at Samarth Bharat, which reflects diligent effort and dedicated work. As we look back on years of hard work and growth, I am reminded of the vision of Pujya Bhaorao Deoras Ji: “Our aim should be to make the socially and economically weaker sections of society self-sufficient and live with pride.”

In August 2020, with COVID-19 cases rising and many losing jobs, Samarth Bharat launched skill training programs for Delhi-NCR youth. We offered training in 12 different areas to help them find work. Our goal to create a complete support system for self-employment has made a positive impact on the socio-economic status of unemployed youth by leveraging opportunities in both organized and unorganized sectors.

Due to the rigorous efforts of the team, we have been able to establish 27 skill development centers and create an impact on 12,000 lives through various job fairs and interventions. Our focus is on market-demand-driven skill development programs and the entrepreneurial ecosystem for sustainable livelihoods.

I am deeply grateful to everyone associated with Samarth Bharat, including our dedicated volunteers, tireless coordinators, invaluable partners and generous donors, for their unwavering support and commitment. Let us resolve to build a nation where every individual can thrive and live a dignified life.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

Samarth Bharat's Skill Development Program since its inception has made a significant impact in addressing unemployment and bridging the skill gaps among the youth. Operating across 27 centers with 12 diverse training modules including Air Conditioning (AC) & refrigerator installation and repair, home appliances repair, mobile repair, basic computer, Goods and Services Tax (GST) & tally, beautician, nail art, hair stylist, bakery, cutting & tailoring, carpenter & plumber and automobile mechanic. These programs have become a ray of hope for thousands of individuals, guiding them towards meaningful employment and entrepreneurial opportunities. A testament to its mission, the initiative has ensured a nurturing environment where participants are trainees as well as members of Samarth Bharat family, receiving unwavering support in every aspect of their professional journey.

SAMARTH BHARAT CENTERS IN DELHI-NCR



CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTERS (CDCs)

Samarth Bharat in collaboration with the University of Delhi has embarked on an innovative venture to establish CDCs across various colleges of University of Delhi, aiming to equip students with the necessary tools and insights to navigate the complexities of entrepreneurship and the startup world.

THESE CDCs

- Are a comprehensive hub for student development.
- Connect students with industry experts and renowned successful startup founders, while also providing mentorship programs featuring talks and guidance by young achievers and accomplished alumni of University of Delhi.



- Provide a platform for startup and innovation through an idea launch-pad, incubation center.
- Facilitate an access to Venture Capitalists (VCs) and angel investors.
- Offer an Entrepreneur Development Program (EDP) that includes content, guidance and networking.
- Offer career counselling, alongside training sessions aimed at enhancing skills, personality and employability of the students.



CDC initiative took a major step forward on February 7th, 2023, with a launch program held at the University of Delhi. This program marked the official launch of the CDCs. The event brought together distinguished guests, featuring unicorn startup founders, Venture Capitalists (VCs) and university officials. This diverse group alongside a vibrant student community, created a dynamic atmosphere for exploring multiple career possibilities.





The program was informative and inspirational. Success stories from prominent figures in the entrepreneurial and professional landscape were showcased, offering valuable insights and emphasizing potential pathways for future generations. The CDC launch signifies a commitment to bridging the gap between academia and industry.

In a significant move to formalize this initiative, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between University of Delhi, the University's School of Open Learning (SOL), Samarth Bharat and 20 colleges affiliated with the University. The number of MoUs with colleges has now increased to 30. This collaboration underscores the effort and commitment towards nurturing a supportive ecosystem for student development and entrepreneurial advancement.



FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (FDP) ON DESIGN THINKING AND INNOVATION

The FDP on Design Thinking and Innovation organized by Samarth Bharat in association with Udhmodya Foundation, University of Delhi and Mahatma Hansraj Faculty Development Centre (Malaviya Mission Centre, Under the UGC Malaviya Mission Scheme) Hansraj College, University of Delhi was conducted from 11th to 18th September 2023.





It was a comprehensive and innovative design program to actively engage a select group of faculty members from the University in the principles of design thinking and innovation across various domains. The program offered an exploration of topics and concepts essential for nurturing an innovative mindset, with each session contributing significantly to the development of a robust knowledge base among the teachers. Notably, the program saw the participation of 84 distinguished faculty members from the University, marking a significant engagement from the academic community. Overall, the program aimed at motivating faculty members to serve as catalysts in fostering and promoting students' entrepreneurial spirit and facilitating their startup journeys.



STARTUP ACCELERATOR PROGRAM (SAP)

A two-day Startup Accelerator Program (SAP), held on October 27th-28th 2023, exemplified a successful collaboration between Samarth Bharat- CDC, Udhmodya Foundation, University of Delhi and School of Open Learning (SOL), University of Delhi. This program generated significant interest, attracting a nationwide pool of 351 aspiring entrepreneurs eager for



mentorship and potential funding opportunities.

The evaluation process was meticulously designed, encompassing two distinct verticals to cater to the needs of emerging entrepreneurs.

- The first vertical, the Venture Capital Round, was tailored for startups that were already generating revenue and had reached the growth stage.





- The second vertical, the Seed Fund Round, was tailored to budding entrepreneurs at various stages of development, including ideation, prototype and traction.

The outstanding success of SAP is reflected by 20 startups incubated and 13 startups have established their offices at Udhmodya Foundation, University of Delhi. The Foundation has successfully funded four startups.

These 24 startups stood out for their potential to drive innovation and create a significant impact in their respective domains.



STARTUP FESTIVAL

The Management Education and Research Institute (MERI) Group of Institutions, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, in partnership with Samarth Bharat, convened a momentous event- the MERI Startup Hub's 5-Continent Mega Startup Festival. Held on December 11th-12th, 2023, at MERI College, Janakpuri, New Delhi, this festival transcended geographical boundaries, bringing together innovators and entrepreneurs from India, Dubai, Australia, USA, Iceland, Africa, Germany and England.

The event served as an unprecedented platform for celebrating innovation and encouraging global collaboration within the startup ecosystem. With 70 startups registered, the festival witnessed a surge of entrepreneurial spirit. As many as 38 startups presented their groundbreaking ideas through captivating pitch decks.

SUCCESS

Samarth Bharat is dedicated to empowering those in need through Skill Development Program. Following are some of the glimpses from few selected success stories from our trainees, showcasing their journeys of transformation and empowerment. These narratives include both AC and Beautician trainee success stories, illustrating the impact of vocational training on *individuals' lives*.

Success Stories of AC Trainees



Devraj Singh used to run his own business, but it shut down during the COVID-19 pandemic, severely affecting his family's financial situation. At a loss about what to do, a friend told him about Samarth Bharat and the courses it offers. He registered for the AC and Refrigerator course at the New Ashok Nagar center on December 6, 2021. The training was quite thorough and lasted for a month. After completing the course, Devraj started his own business in AC and refrigerator repair. He is now able to support his family well and has hired five employees who are also earning decent and supporting their respective families.



Mangal Singh, a resident of Trilok Puri, owns a shop called Tanishka Electricals, where he initially performed general electrical repair work. Though the income was modest, it was sufficient to support his family. However, the pandemic compelled him to shut it down, leaving him without work. During this time, he learned about Samarth Bharat, which offered a one-month course on AC and refrigerator repair. Determined to enhance his skills, Mangal Singh diligently attended the training, where the trainer provided detailed explanations and answered all his queries thoroughly.

After completing the course, Mangal Singh began repairing ACs and refrigerators at his shop and offering home services. Gradually, he started receiving more work from various locations. To manage the increasing workload, he brought in some of his classmates from Samarth Bharat, Tejpal, Deepak, and Anil, to assist him with different assignments. Together, they are all earning well and supporting their families.



Rajkumar comes from an ordinary family and faced financial difficulties that prevented him from pursuing quality education. In his search for work, he struggled to find a suitable job despite many efforts. One day, while passing by, he noticed a board of Samarth Bharat offering training in AC and refrigerator repair. He was happy to learn that the course was only a month long, at a minimal fee, and included government certification. The training program thoroughly covered every topic, both theoretically and practically. After having completed the training, Rajkumar is able to support his family decently..



Basant Kumar had been struggling to find work since the outbreak of COVID-19 due to a lack of specialized skills. Upon hearing about the AC and refrigerator course offered at Samarth Bharat from a friend, he decided to enroll. After completing the training, Basant acquired new skills that he previously lacked. Instead of seeking employment elsewhere, he began offering his services directly at people's homes. To ensure quality and avoid mistakes, he teamed up with his classmate from Samarth Bharat, Ketan. As their reputation grew, they started receiving more and better job opportunities. Now, both Basant and Ketan are earning well and able to provide their children with a good life and quality education.

Mansi, a student at Samarth Bharat's Malviya Nagar Center, Batch 3, has successfully established her own beauty studio in Chhatarpur, Delhi. OTHER INITIATIVES

The organization undertakes a range of impactful activities aimed at supporting underprivileged communities. Among these, three primary initiatives stand out: Vishram Sadan, Scholarship, and Education. Along with Samarth Bharat, these three activities are the main pillars of our efforts. These programs address critical needs in healthcare, financial assistance for education, and the holistic development of students, contributing significantly to the betterment of society. Below is an overview of these three core activities.

VISHRAM SADANs

Recognizing the significant challenge faced by families seeking treatment at major hospitals, Nyas established the Vishram Sadan initiative. This program addresses the critical need for affordable and comfortable accommodation for patients and their attendants near medical facilities. Many individuals from underprivileged backgrounds are forced to make do with inadequate housing options, such as hospital corridors or roadsides. Vishram Sadan provides a dignified and sanitary alternative at a cost these families can manage. Through the Vishram Sadan program, Nyas offers solace and comfort to those facing medical challenges, ensuring they have a supportive environment to focus on healing and recovery.

SCHOLARSHIP

In pursuit of Nyas' founding vision, our commitment to fostering access to education stands resolute. Shri Bhaorao Deoras ji's visionary mentorship catalysed the establishment of the first Saraswati Shishu Mandir in Gorakhpur, laying the foundational stones of knowledge for the youth of the country. Our trust endeavours to nurture the academic aspirations of bright young minds from Classes 5 to Postgraduate and Professional courses through the Bhaorao Deoras Memorial Scholarship. Since its inception in 1995-96, in collaboration with Bhartia Shiksha Parishad, the Nyas awards scholarships totalling to rupees 5 to 8 lakh annually to meritorious students hailing from regions including Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Jammu & Kashmir, and the North-Eastern States.

Over the years, the scope of our scholarship program has expanded significantly, now encompassing students from Class 1 to postgraduate levels. As of the year 2023-24, a total of 1,859 deserving students have been beneficiaries of this initiative, with approximately 250 students receiving support annually. Notably, in the year 2023-24, 244 students were awarded scholarships. In addition to our scholarship program, our trustees extend financial support ranging from Rs. 1-2 lakh to educational institutions dedicated to promoting Bharatiya Sanskriti, life-values, and nationality among teachers and students alike.

EDUCATION

Mahamana Shikshan Sansthaan and Mahamana Shikshan Sansthaan- Balika Prkalp are two pivotal initiatives dedicated to empowering students from underprivileged backgrounds through education. These programs not only provide academic support but also shape future leaders who can contribute positively to society. Below is a detailed overview highlighting their significant impact and achievements.

Mahamana Shikshan Sansthan

It was launched on January 19, 2019. It aims to foster the holistic development of meritorious students. The institution's core mission is to strengthen students through education, providing them with innovative opportunities to develop self-confidence, social and economic independence, and leadership abilities. The focus is not only on academic excellence but also on cultural and personality development. Since its inception, the Sansthan has admitted 114 students, with impressive outcomes. Among the first three batches, most students have successfully secured admissions in prestigious technical institutes and government engineering and medical colleges across the country. For example, in the first batch preparing for I.I.T. JEE, 5 out of 7 students were admitted to top institutes and similar success has been observed in subsequent batches. This initiative is instrumental in transforming the lives of talented students, ensuring they become educated minds and agents of positive change in their families and communities.

Mahamana Shikshan Sansthaan - Balika Prkalp

This initiative by Bhaorao Deoras Seva Nyas is committed to providing free education to girl students from economically weaker sections. The program is designed to identify bright students who lack financial resources but possess the potential to excel in competitive exams across various streams. As part of this residential program, students receive top-tier education, access to quality coaching and tuition. They are provided with all necessary resources, including books and a free hostel with meals. By 2023-24, the program had successfully admitted 48 students, enabling them to enhance their skills and knowledge to compete in graduation and professional courses. This initiative plays a crucial role in helping these students reach their full potential and build a promising future.

THREE DECADES OF TRANSFORMATIVE IMPACT: KEY ACHIEVEMENTS AND MILESTONES

Since its establishment, BDSN has consistently worked towards its mission of serving the marginalized communities across Bharat. Through its various initiatives, including Samarth Bharat, the organization has made significant strides in healthcare, education, and social welfare. This section details the key achievements of BDSN over the past 30 years, highlighting the organization's far-reaching contributions.

Healthcare Initiatives

- **Swasthya Seva Prakalp:** Over the past three decades, this initiative has provided critical healthcare services to 4,73,003 patients. The Prakalp has distributed 6,048 assistive devices to the handicapped and elderly, improving their quality of life. In addition, 59,984 children have received polio drops as part of BDSN's commitment to public health.
- **Vishram Sadan Facilities:** BDSN has established several Vishram Sadans near major hospitals to provide affordable accommodations for patients and their families. These facilities, including those near SGPGI Lucknow, AIIMS Delhi, IGIMS Patna, KGMU Lucknow, and AIIMS Jhajjar, serve thousands of individuals annually. The latest addition, Madhav Seva Vishram Sadan near AIIMS Rishikesh, will offer 430 beds when completed in 2024.
- **Netra Chikitsalaya:** Focused on vision care, this initiative has screened 33,725 individuals. Out of these, 12,801 patients have received spectacles, and 4,484 patients have undergone cataract surgeries. The program's success is further highlighted by the 2,835 pathological tests conducted to ensure comprehensive eye care.
- **Netra-Kumbh Initiative:** During the 2019 Kumbh festival in Prayagraj, this ambitious project screened 2,00,000 individuals and distributed 1,50,000 spectacles. This achievement was recognized in the Limca Book of Records.
- **Akshay Seva Prakalp:** Originally started as a short-term initiative, this program has grown to distribute food to over 60 lakh individuals. During the COVID-19 pandemic, BDSN mobilized resources to deliver over 10 lakh food packets across Delhi NCR. The initiative continues to serve around 2,500 individuals daily at various centers, ensuring that no one goes hungry.

Educational Support

Education has always been at the forefront of the organization's mission, guided by the visionary mentorship of Shri Bhaorao Deoras ji. His influence led to the establishment of the first Saraswati Shishu Mandir in Gorakhpur, laying the foundation for nurturing young minds across the country. The Bhaorao Deoras Memorial Scholarship, initiated in 1995-96 in collaboration with Bhartiya Shiksha Parishad, exemplifies this commitment. Over the years, the scholarship program has expanded significantly, supporting students from Class 1 to postgraduate and professional courses.

Since its inception, the scholarship program has awarded financial aid to a total of 1,875 students, disbursing ₹1.1 crore in scholarships. The program now benefits around 250 students annually, with 244 students receiving support in the 2023-24 academic year.

In addition to the scholarship program, the trustees of the organization have extended financial support ranging from ₹1-2 lakh to educational institutions dedicated to promoting Bharatiya Sanskriti, values, and a sense of nationality among both teachers and students.

Social Awareness

The organization actively promotes social awareness through initiatives that celebrate the legacy of cultural and social leaders. Programs like the Bhaorao Deoras Memorial Lecture and Smriti Seva Samman recognize individuals who contribute to society through selfless service, inspiring others to follow suit. The 29th Pt. Pratap Narayan Mishra Memorial Young Litterateur Award also plays a crucial role in encouraging and honoring young writers, fostering cultural expression and pride.

Publications

Publications such as Seva Chetna and Seva Samwad are key tools for the organization to spread its message of service and community building. Seva Chetna showcases the organization's initiatives and stories of impact, while Seva Samwad fosters dialogue among those dedicated to social upliftment. Together, these publications help sustain a shared commitment to the organization's mission and values.

BDSN remains committed to expanding its impact in the coming years. The organization plans to increase the capacity of its existing programs and aims to further enhance its services to reach even more individuals in need.
